Your Certificate provides additional information about your Delta Dental plan, including information about plan exclusions and limitations. If a statement in this Summary conflicts with a statement in the Certificate, the statement in this Summary applies to you and you should ignore the conflicting statement in the Certificate. The percentages below are applied to Delta Dental's allowance for each service and it may vary due to the dentist's network participation.*

* When you receive services from a Nonparticipating Dentist, the percentages in this column indicate the portion of Delta Dental's Nonparticipating Dentist Fee that will be paid for those services. This amount may be less than what the Dentist charges or Delta Dental approves and you are responsible for that difference.

- Comprehensive and problem focused oral evaluations are payable twice in any period of 12 consecutive months when performed in conjunction with periodontic, endodontic and oral surgery services. Patient screening is not a Covered Service.
- Prophylaxes (cleanings) are not payable. Periodontal maintenance procedures are payable twice in any period of 12 consecutive months. Two additional periodontal maintenance procedures are payable in any 12-month period for individuals with a documented history of periodontal disease.
- People with specific at-risk health conditions may be eligible for additional prophylaxes (cleanings) or fluoride treatment. The patient should talk with his or her dentist about treatment.
- Bitewing X-rays and full mouth X-rays are not Covered Services. A panorex is payable once in any five-year period when performed in conjunction with periodontic, endodontic, or oral surgery services.
- Six periapical X-rays are payable in any 12-month period when performed in conjunction with periodontic, endodontic and oral surgery services.
- Pulp vitality tests are a Covered Service. Caries risk assessment is not a Covered Service.
- Composite resin (white) restorations are optional treatment on posterior teeth.
- Porcelain and resin facings on crowns are optional treatment on posterior teeth.
- Most oral surgery services, including TMD treatment, performed by a dentist are Covered Services.
- Benefits for Temporomandibular Disorders (TMD) are limited to those services normally provided by a dentist to relieve oral symptoms associated with malfunctioning of the temporomandibular joint, including appliance therapy and surgical correction. This does not include services that would normally be provided under medical care. Predetermination is required when TMD treatment will exceed \$250 or no coverage will be made.
- Full and complete dentures, and services related to dentures are not Covered Services.
- Implants and implant related services are not Covered Services.
- Crowns over implants and their related services are not Covered Services.
- Limited occlusal adjustments are Covered Services. Occlusal guards are not Covered Services.
- Coverage includes treatment of accidental injuries to sound natural teeth rendered within 12 months of the date of the accident.

Maximum Payment - \$1,000 per person total per Benefit Year on all services.

Deductible - None.

Eligible People - All Retirees, Surviving Spouses, and Dependents as those terms are defined in paragraphs 1.4, 1.16, and 1.17 of the Retirees of the Goodyear Tire & Rubber Company Health Care Plan.

Also eligible are your Spouse and your Children to the end of the calendar year in which they attain the age of 19, and your Dependent unmarried Children who are chiefly dependent upon you for support and maintenance, including but not limited to Children with permanent disabilities.

The medical and Delta Dental plans are offered as a package. Employees enrolled in either plan are automatically enrolled in both plans with the same type of coverage. For example, employees enrolled with single coverage under the medical plan must also be enrolled with single coverage under the Delta Dental plan.

Coordination of Benefits - If you and your Spouse are both eligible to enroll in This Plan as Enrollees, you may be enrolled as both an Enrollee on your own application and as a Dependent on your Spouse's application. Your Dependent Children may be enrolled on both your and your Spouse's applications as well. Delta Dental will coordinate benefits between your coverage and your Spouse's coverage.

Benefits will cease on the last day of the month in which the employee is terminated.
